Shalom from Shelby

When Thomas Merton discusses faith in his book, New Seeds of Contemplation, he first makes the claim that “the beginning of contemplation is faith.” Faith, he says, is not just a feeling or a vague urge toward the supernatural. It is not an opinion or something proven to you by science. Rather, Merton invites us to think about faith as an act of belief that, “puts the intellect in possession of Truth which reason cannot grasp by itself.”

So what does it mean to have true faith? How can we attain it and how do we know once we have? I like to think about faith as a process by which we believe. It's non-linear and sometimes penetrated by doubts. But doubt is nothing to be ashamed of! In fact, it often strengthens our faith! Merton describes the act of faith as an act “which the intellect is content to know God by loving Him and accepting His statements about Himself on His own terms.” Our faith is about loving God and accepting that God reveals Gods-self to us in unexpected and beautiful ways. In this way, Merton claims, we “receive” God ourselves.

Faith is messy and hard sometimes, but it is also what keeps us going as followers of Christ. “Above all,” Merton says, “faith is the opening of an inward eye, the eye of the heart, to be filled with the presence of Divine light.” As the song goes, “Open the eyes of my heart, Lord... I want to see you.”

Highlights of the April 11 Board Meeting:

There were 22 Board members, 3 staff, and 4 guests present.

The Board approved the following motions:

- Outreach Committee: \$6,650.93 from the Legacy Foundation Outreach Funds be divided as follows: Camp Christian - \$900; Commission to Every Nation - \$200; Cleveland Christian Home - \$300; Disciples LGBTQ+ Alliance - \$200; Feeding Medina County - \$1,600; Francis House Recovery - \$200; Free Clinic of Medina County - \$500; The Garage Ministry - \$200; Helping Haitians in Need - \$800; Wadsworth Salvation Army - \$800.
- Jerry Ritzman: Approval of up to \$2,000 to cover the expenses related to the review of council on the lease agreement between First Christian Church and Wadsworth City School.

KINDOM OF GOD WITHIN US AMONG US

GENESIS 11:1-9 • LUKE 17:20-21 • 2 PETER 1:3

July 29 - August 1, 2023 - Louisville

Summer Sermon Series - "Kindom of God: Within Us, Among Us"

This sermon series will focus on the ways God's kingdom was established by Jesus Christ to heal and restore and unite. The series was created by the General Church to engage Disciples churches in scripture study and reflection in preparation for our bi-annual gathering of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) in Louisville, KY July 29 - Aug. 1st.

The theme for the 2023 General Assembly of the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) is "Kindom of God: Within Us, Among Us." As Rev. Yvonne Gilmore, Associate General Minister wrote: 'Kindom' is not a spelling error or a replacement for the word kingdom. It's a way of connecting the "kin" that God makes and expanding our imagination about Jesus." (more on this in next month's newsletter)

I see this sermon series as an opportunity to come together as the world tries to pull us apart. The General Church introduces the series this way:

In the last few years, violent political radicalization, a literal plague, cascading natural disasters, all have served to deepen fractures in our faith communities and bodies of belonging. We are much more likely to imagine our neighbor as our enemy than as our kin in the body of Christ. Neither this sermon series, nor the long-delayed General Assembly, will heal these deep wounds. But we can conceive of them as a beginning, a chance to communally reimagine the church and the part we play in either its flourishing or its suffering. By using our time as a denominational body and as individual worshipping bodies to dwell on what it means to be the Kin-dom of God, we invite the Holy Spirit to once again reorient us around the True Love which saves and liberates and unites us all. Remember what Paul taught the church in Ephesus: “now you are no longer strangers and aliens. Rather, you are fellow citizens with God's people, and you belong to God's household.” We became God's household because Christ came and dwelled amongst us, bringing the Kin-dom of God near. Christ's power and presence is not diminished! Despite our estrangement, we still remain fellow citizens, the household of God. The Kin-dom of God is here.

Join us for this six week series (June 18 - July 23) as we focus on unity and the power of God's Spirit within us and among us!




